2	Recent & Current Activities	<p>1.) Originally, on May 1, 2013, Barbara Kapler, Building Inspector, called to inform me that the homeowner at 1303 W. Canterbury Ct., subject of a previous complaint relating to their extended driveway possibly violating the 30% impervious surface restriction, would voluntarily remove the driveway extension. On June 3, July 3, and August 21, 2013, I called Ms. Kapler for a status report. She indicated that the homeowner is being given some additional time to remove the driveway; however, she assured me that the extended driveway located at the front of the property will be removed in the very near future. On August 28, 2013, Ms. Kapler informed me that she is meeting with the homeowners and their architect on August 30, 2013 to determine why the driveway has not been brought into conformance. <i>Case remains open.</i></p> <p>2.) On July 3, 2013, I spoke with Building Inspector Barbara Kapler regarding the lack of a permit being obtained to replace a front porch roof at 1214 N. Clinton. Ms. Kapler gave the homeowners notice of the need to file a CD Work Review Form, which they have submitted. The City has determined that the metal roof is not a violation of the CD ordinance. <i>Case closed.</i></p> <p>3.) On July 29, 2013, I contacted City Planner Margaret Fiskell to inquire if the homeowner at 1203 Winnetka submitted a Work Review Form prior to constructing a gravel driveway extension (which they did <u>not</u>). The City gave the homeowners 10 days to submit a Work Review Form, which they have submitted. The City determined that the gravel driveway did not violate Subarea 1's 30% front yard impervious surface restriction. <i>Case closed.</i></p>
